## #9250 Complete Goat Creep\*

This all natural 21% expanded mini-pellet, designed for young kids, contains a blend of proteins, chelated trace minerals and multiple carbohydrate sources including whey for superior performance. To be used as a creep and early weaning feed. *Contains Citristim*

## #9251 Complete Goat Starter\*

An all natural 18% expanded pelleted starter formulated for young kids ages 0-4 months. This starter feed contains a blend of proteins, chelated trace minerals and multiple carbohydrate sources including whey for superior performance. *Contains Citristim*

## #9252 Complete Goat Grower\*

Designed to meet the needs of growing kids this all natural 16% expanded grower pellet contains chelated trace minerals and a blend of multiple carbohydrates. Feed from 5-10 months of age for optimum growth. *Contains Citristim*

**\*Contains Rumensin for coccidiosis control and ammonium chloride for the prevention of urinary calculi.**

## #9130 Dry Goat

Designed with the dry goat needs in mind, this all natural 15% protein, expanded pellet is perfect for your dry does, bucks and companion goats.

## #9120 Lactating Goat

An all natural 16% expanded pellet especially designed for the lactating doe. Ample nutrition, fortified with multiple protein, chelated trace minerals and carbohydrate sources readily meets the additional demands of maximum production.

## #9255 Lactating Goat HF (high feeding)

18% complete feed designed to be fed to dairy does during lactation. Expanded blend of protein and carbohydrates to maximize milk production with quality alfalfa hay. Feeding rates over 4 pounds should be achieved to maximize milk production; feed at least four and up to six times daily along with 1-2 lbs. of quality hay. Feed at the rate of 1-1.25lb./2 lbs. of desired milk production.

## #5090 Goat T.M. Salt with Selenium & Vitamins

To be fed free choice to provide salt, trace minerals & vitamins. Intakes from 1/4 to 1/2 ounce per head per day.

## #5077 Goat Mineral

To be fed free choice to provide salt, minerals, trace minerals and vitamins with copper. Intakes from 3/4 to 1 oz./head/day. **Do not feed to bucks and wethers.**

## #9220 Dairy Goat Supplement

This 35% expanded protein pellet is designed to be mixed with corn to make a 14% or 16% complete feed. With high levels of by-pass protein and a blend of natural protein sources, minerals and vitamins this supplement supplies optimum nutrition for maximum milk production.

## COMPLETE GOAT FEEDING GUIDE

Product	Age	Amount
Goat Creep	3 days - 2 months	0.1 - 0.5 lb./hd/day - feed daily, keep fresh
Goat Starter	2 - 4 months	0.75 - 1.5 lbs./hd/day - full feed
Goat Grower	5 - 10 months	1.75 - 2.5 lbs./hd/day - feed to condition
Dry Goat	Over 10 months	1/2 - 1 lb. per day depending on desired condition and forage quality
Lactating Goat	During lactating	3/4 - 1 lb. per 2 lbs. milk produced and depending on forage quality
Goat T.M.	All ages	Free Choice
Goat Mineral	All ages	Free Choice - Does ONLY

### PRODUCT INFORMATION

The Big Gain Goat program has been developed to fit the various life stages of dairy, meat and companion goats. These stages determine the nutrient needs of the goat, generally the more activity (lactation, growth, late pregnancy) the greater the nutrient needs. The feeding guidelines are based on vitamin/trace mineral fortification and basic energy requirements.

- All complete feeds are expanded pellets which help to reduce fines, waste & provide increased carbohydrate utilization.
- Feeds contain no animal byproducts.
- All products contain apple flavoring to enhance palatability and to maintain continuity among the products.

### MANAGEMENT TIPS

- Provide a draft free, dry, clean environment.
- Offer fresh feed each day.
- Have fresh, clean water available at all times.
- Limit high quality hay for maximum gain.
- Keep feeding equipment clean and sanitized.
- Wean at 60 days of age & achieve 30 - 35 lbs.
- Consult Veterinarian for vaccination and CAE prevention programs.
